This communication is not just about the school communicating but requires parents, pupils and staff to feel able to communicate their views, thoughts, aspirations, concerns and ideas.

#### How can staff communicate with parents?

- Outside at drop off/pick up
- Parents' evenings
- Written reports
- Curriculum / information workshops
- Weekly newsletters (including separate Early Years version)
- Weduc messages
- Weduc newsfeed Class Dojo
- Via the school website
- Via Google Classroom (to share homework or home learning)
- By telephone (usually at the end of the school day)

#### How can parents communicate with the school?


- · At drop off/pick up with the class teacher/teaching assistant outside\*
- By telephone, asking for the class teacher to contact outside of teaching / lesson time
- Via Class Dojo\*\* (when contacting class teachers/TAs)
- Requesting appointments for a meeting via the class teacher/school office
- Contacting the School Office via Weduc (method for reporting absences; holiday requests; medicine forms, etc.)

We insist that parents do not contact staff via their staff email account; social media or on their personal mobile phones.
